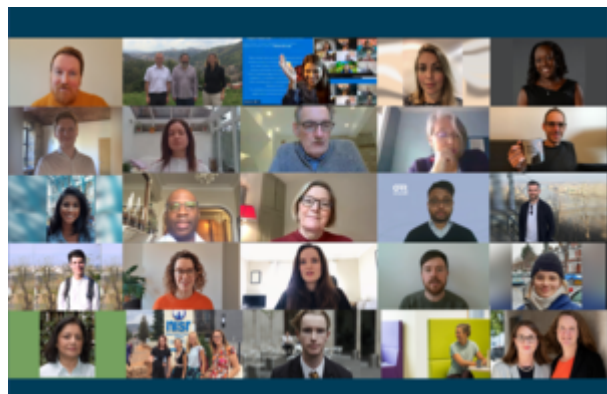


Analysis Function Strategy review 2022
