

Appointment of Executive Director (Policy) of Mandatory Provident Fund Schemes Authority

The Financial Secretary, in exercise of the authority under the Mandatory Provident Fund Schemes Ordinance (Cap. 485) (MPFSO) delegated to him by the Chief Executive, has appointed Mr Eric Cheng Siu-fun as the Executive Director (Policy) of the Mandatory Provident Fund Schemes Authority (MPFA) for a period of three years from July 1, 2023, to June 30, 2026, both dates inclusive.

Announcing the appointment today (June 28), a spokesperson for the Financial Services and the Treasury Bureau said, "Having served as head of the MPFA's policy development and research division since 2021, Mr Cheng has been playing an active role in taking forward important legislative amendment exercises for the benefit of Mandatory Provident Fund (MPF) scheme members. We are confident that Mr Cheng will continue to make invaluable contributions to the reform of the MPF System."

The MPFA is a statutory body established under the MPFSO in September 1998 for the regulation and supervision of the MPF System.
