

Appointments to Advisory Committee on Agriculture and Fisheries

The Government announced today (May 30) that the Secretary for Environment and Ecology has appointed the new term of membership of the Advisory Committee on Agriculture and Fisheries (ACAF). The appointments are for a term of two years from June 1, 2025, to May 31, 2027.
