

Appointments to Advisory Committee on Mental Health announced

The Government announced today (March 1) the reappointment of two incumbent members of the Advisory Committee on Mental Health, who were appointed through the Member Self-recommendation Scheme for Youth earlier.

The two reappointed members are Miss Angel Chan Hoi-yi and Mr Ikey Cheung Ho-yuen. Their appointments will take effect from March 1, 2025, to November 30, 2027.

Established in December 2017, the Advisory Committee on Mental Health advises the Government on mental health policies, including the adoption of a more integrated and comprehensive approach to tackle various issues related to mental health in Hong Kong. It assists the Government in formulating policies, strategies and measures related to mental health, while following up on and monitoring the implementation of the recommendations of the Mental Health Review Report, with a view to enhancing mental health services in Hong Kong.
