- 200 metres of any residential dwelling or workplace

<u>Statutory guidance: SR2015 No 23:</u> <u>treatment of waste wood for recovery</u>

The total quantity of waste you can store and treat under these standard rules is no more than 5,000 tonnes per year.

<u>Statutory guidance: SR2015 No 16:</u> <u>metal recycling site</u>

These standard rules allow you to operate a metal recycling site at a specified location.

Using hand-held equipment only, these rules permit the following activities for ferrous metals or alloys and non-ferrous metals for recovery:

- sorting
- separation
- grading
- shearing
- baling
- compacting
- granulating of cables
- cutting

The total quantity of waste that can be accepted at a site under these rules must be less than 25,000 tonnes a year.

The rules will not permit the burning of any waste, either in the open, inside buildings or in any form of incinerator.
