Beware of counterfeit mobile apps purporting to be made by Guangdong-Hong Kong-Macao Greater Bay Area Development Office

Members of the public should stay vigilant and are strongly advised not to visit or download them. The Office has not provided mobile apps on any online platform about the joint development of the Guangdong-Hong Kong-Macao Greater Bay Area. Members of the public should report to the local police as soon as practicable if a scam is suspected.
