

CE leads delegation to visit Cambodia (with photos/videos)

â€‹The Chief Executive, Mr John Lee, led a Hong Kong Special Administrative Region delegation to arrive in Phnom Penh, Cambodia, today (July 30) and continue their duty visit.

Upon arriving in Phnom Penh, Mr Lee attended a luncheon hosted by the Ambassador Extraordinary and Plenipotentiary of the People's Republic of China to the Kingdom of Cambodia, Mr Wang Wenbin.
