

# [CEDD to hold slope safety exhibition](#)

The Civil Engineering and Development Department (CEDD) will hold the "Hong Kong Slope Safety Exhibition – Proper Slope Maintenance for Worry-free Life" from tomorrow (February 26) to March 2 at The Wai in Tai Wai to enhance public understanding of the importance of slope safety and proper slope maintenance.

With the support of the Buildings Department (BD) and the Lands Department (LandsD), the exhibition will provide slope safety and maintenance information through display panels and docent service, as well as interactive games offering souvenirs to participants.

The exhibition will be held between 11am and 8pm from tomorrow to March 1 and between 11am and 7pm on March 2 on the 4/F of The Wai in Tai Wai. Admission is free.

Building surveyors and structural engineers from the BD will provide information on the maintenance of private slopes at the exhibition. A senior estate surveyor from the LandsD will explain the use of the Slope Maintenance Responsibility Information System to the public from 3pm to 6pm on February 27 and 28, and a geotechnical engineer from the CEDD will answer questions on slope safety and maintenance from 1pm to 3pm on March 1 and 2.
