

Correctional officers stop remand person in custody attacking staff member

â€œCorrectional officers at Lai Chi Kok Reception Centre stopped a male remand person in custody attacking a staff member today (March 2).

At 1.36pm today, a 61-year-old male remand person in custody suddenly became emotional and attacked a correctional officer inside a hospital ward. Officers at the scene immediately ordered the assailant to stop.

During the incident, the officer sustained an injury to his mouth. After examination and treatment by the institution Medical Officer, he was referred to a public hospital for further treatment. The assailant did not sustain any injuries.

The case has been reported to the Police for investigation.

The assailant was remanded for the offence of wounding with intent in March 2025.
