

Statutory guidance: Bird flu: poultry meat from a protection zone identification mark

Mark which must be used to identify poultry meat from a protection zone.

Statutory guidance: Bird flu: licence to move table eggs into, within or out of a protection or surveillance zone in England, Scotland or Wales (EXD243(AI)(GB))

You should use this licence to move table eggs into, within or out of a protection or surveillance zone.

Statutory guidance: Bird flu: licence to move table eggs from a premises in a free area to an egg processing plant in a protection or surveillance zone (EXD541 (HPAI) GB)

You should use this licence to move table eggs from a premises in a free area to an egg processing plant in a protection zone or surveillance zone.

Statutory guidance: Bird flu: licence to move hatching eggs from a premises in a protection zone or surveillance zone for scientific purposes (EXD539(HPAI)(GB))

You should use this licence to move hatching eggs from a premises in a protection zone or surveillance zone to a designated premises.

Statutory guidance: Bird flu: licence to move carcasses and samples from live poultry or other captive birds from a protection or surveillance zone (EXD415(HPAI)(GB))

This licence allows you to move carcasses, samples, faeces and faecal samples from live poultry or other captive birds.
