

Import live animals and germinal products to Great Britain under Balai rules

When to follow Balai rules to import animals and germinal products to Great Britain.

Statutory guidance: Bluetongue: general licences to move animals and germinal product from the restricted zone in England to Scotland or Wales

Use these general licences to move animals and germinal product from the bluetongue restricted zone in England to Scotland or Wales (EXD603, EXD608, EXD639, EXD656, EXD657, EXD658, EXD661, EXD662, EXD667).

Guidance: Bird flu: rules on meat produced from poultry and farmed game birds originating in disease control zones

Rules food businesses should follow for any meat produced from poultry or farmed game birds originating within a disease control zone.

Quota application mechanism: apply for 2026 English quota

Use the quota application mechanism (QAM) to apply for English fishing quota.

Transparency data: Multi-Annual National Control Plan (MANCP): annual reports

MANCP annual reports provide official control data and activities for Great Britain relating to feed and food safety, animal health and welfare (including aquatics), and plant health.
