## **[Notice: Snow Sewer Warping Drain, Isle of Axholme catchment: proposal for designation change](#)**

*Updated:* Addition of notice for proposed change

The Environment Agency consults the public about proposals to change whether a river or stream is designated as a main river. Main rivers are usually larger rivers and streams. The Environment Agency carries out maintenance, improvement or construction work on main rivers to manage flood risk.

For the Snow Sewer Warping Drain stretch of Main River, the Environment Agency has published:

- the proposal for change notice (consultation now closed and is pending a decision)
