Policy paper: Draft Environment (Principles and Governance) Bill 2018

The draft Environment Bill sets out how we will maintain environmental standards as we leave the EU and build on the vision of the 25 Year Environment Plan.

We are seeking views on proposals to introduce a deposit return scheme for drinks containers in England, Wales and Northern Ireland.

<u>Consultation outcome: Biodiversity net</u> <u>gain: updating planning requirements</u>

Seeking views on how we can improve the planning system in England to protect the environment (biodiversity net gain) and build places to live and work.

Consultation outcome: Waste and recycling: making recycling collections consistent in England

Seeking views on plans to make local authorities collect the same kind of materials for household recycling and on improving how businesses recycle in England.

<u>Consultation outcome: Improving our</u> <u>management of water in the environment</u>

Seeking views on proposals to modernise water regulation and allow better long-term planning of water resources and drainage.
