

Fatal traffic accident in Mong Kok

Police are investigating a fatal traffic accident in Mong Kok today (March 13) in which a man died.

At about 2.10pm, a light goods vehicle (LGV) driven by the 44-year-old man was travelling along the West Kowloon Highway towards the New Territories. The LGV reportedly went out of control and crashed into a government vehicle that was parked in the same lane attending to a traffic accident.

The LGV driver was trapped inside the compartment and was rescued by firemen. Sustaining serious injuries, he was rushed to Kwong Wah Hospital in unconscious state and was certified dead at 3.20pm.

Investigation by the Special Investigation Team of Traffic, Kowloon West is underway.
