
## Friends of the University of Dundee Botanic Garden event #dundeewestend



As part of the season of Wednesday afternoon lectures, Professor Graeme Walker, Director of the Abertay Yeast Research Group at Abertay University, is giving a talk later this week on the subject of yeasts.

The lecture will take place in the D'Arcy Thompson Lecture Theatre in the Tower Building at the Dundee University, at  $2.15 \, \text{pm}$  this Wednesday - 18th October - at a charge of £2.

Yeasts are the world's premier industrial microbes. Yeast and fermentation technology is entwined with the history of human civilisation — from ancient Egyptian brewing to modern day biotechnology.

This lecture will explore the diversity of yeasts and their products, following a journey from beer to biofuels to biopharmaceuticals and beyond.
