## HAD distributes complimentary COVID-19 rapid test kits to households, cleansing workers and property management staff in Kowloon City, Sai Kung and North Districts

â€<In light of positive test results for the COVID-19 virus from sewage samples collected in Kowloon City, Sai Kung and North Districts, the Home Affairs Department (HAD) said today (October 27) that the Kowloon City District Office (KCDO), the Sai Kung District Office (SKDO) and the North District Office (NDO) have distributed a total of about 99 000 COVID-19 rapid test kits to households, cleansing workers and property management staff living and working in the Districts.

The KCDO commenced distributing rapid test kits to households, cleansing workers and property management staff living and working in Lok Man Sun Chuen, Wing On Court, Greenfield Terrace, Parc Regal and Chun Man Court for voluntary testing through the property management companies and the owners' corporations.

The SKDO also distributed rapid test kits to households, cleansing workers and property management staff living and working in Hong Sing Garden, Kam Po Court, Siu Yat Building, Man Yee Wan New Village and Sha Tsui San Tsuen for voluntary testing through the property management companies.

In addition, the NDO distributed rapid test kits to households, cleansing workers and property management staff living and working in Tai Tong Wu, Hung Leng, Po Kat Tsai, Pine Villa of San Wai Tsuen, Wang Shan Keuk San Tsuen, Pak Tin New Village, Ma Mei Ha, Ma Liu Shui, Lung Yeuk Tau and Kan Lung Tsuen in Fanling, as well as residential premises around San Fung Avenue, for voluntary testing through the village representatives, the property management company and the owners' corporation.

The HAD made the above arrangements in the hope of identifying infected persons early.

Members of the public may refer to the demonstration video produced by the Centre for Health Protection (CHP) under the Department of Health (DH) via <a href="https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=yzFAUzTtmKk">www.youtube.com/watch?v=yzFAUzTtmKk</a> to learn how to use the rapid antigen test (RAT) kit.

Persons testing positive through an RAT should take a photo of the test result and declare the result within 24 hours via the Declaration System for Individuals Tested Positive for COVID-19 Using Rapid Antigen Test (<a href="https://www.chp.gov.hk/ratp">www.chp.gov.hk/ratp</a>). If members of the public encounter difficulties in using the online platform, they can call the automated system at 183 6119 to

register their identification document and telephone number. The CHP under the DH will contact the relevant person later to complete the report procedure. There is no need to declare negative test results.

The Government appeals for the co-operation of members of the public to safeguard the health of themselves and their families by undergoing testing on a voluntary basis and fighting the virus together. The Government urges all individuals who are in doubt about their own health condition, or individuals with infection risks (such as individuals who visited places with epidemic outbreaks or had contact with cases that tested positive), to undergo testing promptly for early identification of infected persons to reduce the transmission risks of COVID-19.
