## <u>June 2019 — Euro area international</u> <u>trade in goods surplus €20.6 bn — €6.1</u> <u>bn surplus for EU28</u>

The first estimate for **euro area** (EA19) exports of goods to the rest of the world in June 2019 was  $\le$ 189.9 billion, a decrease of 4.7% compared with June 2018 ( $\le$ 199.3 bn). Imports from the rest of the world stood at  $\le$ 169.3 bn, a fall of 4.1% compared with June 2018 ( $\le$ 176.6 bn). As a result, the **euro area** recorded a  $\ge$ 20.6 bn surplus in trade in goods with the rest of the world in June 2019, compared with  $+\ge$ 22.6 bn in June 2018. **Intra-euro** area trade fell to  $\ge$ 160.5 bn in June 2019, down by 6.6% compared with June 2018.
