

Mark Leung to host "All that Jazz, Through the Years" lecture demonstration

Well-known jazz guitarist Mark Leung will return to host the "Jazz Up" series: "All that Jazz, Through the Years" lecture demonstration in November. From 2017 to 2019, Leung hosted various lecture demonstrations in the "Jazz Up" series presented by the LCSD, including "Getting to Know Jazz", "Is Jazz That Hard?" and "First Experience of Jazz".
