LEBANON: Lebanese celebrating New Year's Eve are looking back on a period that deepened the political and economic crisis in the country, with 2022 being described as a year of missed opportunities.

"There is no room for any positive opportunity in Lebanon in light of Iranian influence, international confusion and national division," Hariri had said.

<u>UK archives reveal government unease</u> <u>at Mandela mediation over Lockerbie</u>

LONDON: Documents released by the National Archives in the UK have revealed that Tony Blair's government believed Nelson Mandela was "unlikely to be

helpful" in mediation efforts with Libya in the aftermath of the 1988 Lockerbie bombing, but that he could be used "against" Tripoli in the event of negotiating compensation.

At a meeting in London in 2001, former South African President Mandela told Blair that the UK was "wrong to hold Libya legally responsible for the Lockerbie bombing" following the conviction of Abdelbaset Al-Megrahi earlier that year.


