How to apply for compensation if you were a victim of the terrorist attack in Manchester on 22 May 2017

Applications can be made to the <u>Criminal Injuries Compensation Authority</u> <u>(CICA)</u>, under the <u>Criminal Injuries Compensation Scheme 2012</u>, by those victims injured, or the families of those killed in the attack.
