Proposed sewerage works for site formation and engineering infrastructure for Development of San Tin Technopole Phase 1 Works authorised

The Chief Executive in Council has authorised the proposed sewerage works for the site formation and engineering infrastructure for the Development of San Tin Technopole Phase 1 Works. The notice was gazetted today (January 10).

The sewerage works comprise the following:

- 1. construction of about 15 000 metres of gravity sewers and associated manholes;
- 2. construction of about 4 000 metres of twin rising mains, about 2 100 metres of rising mains, associated manholes and sewage outlet;
- construction of three sewage pumping stations;
- 4. construction of an effluent polishing plant; and
- 5. ancillary works including temporary closure and reinstatement/reconstruction of existing carriageways, footpaths, cycle tracks, amenity areas and central medians/refuge islands.

Details of the sewerage works were published in the Government Gazette on March 8, 2024, and March 15, 2024.
