

Protestors commit destructive acts and set fires in Tuen Mun

Attention duty announcers, radio and TV stations:

Please broadcast the following message as soon as possible and repeat it at suitable intervals:

Radical protestors today (September 21) set barricades and started fires at various locations in the vicinity of Tuen Mun town centre, endangering the safety of everyone at scene and seriously affecting traffic nearby. In addition, the Light Rail service is adjusted, including changing the routes and suspension of service. Members of the public are advised to stay tuned to the latest traffic arrangements.

Police will use appropriate force to conduct a dispersal operation, and warn all protestors to stop all illegal acts and leave immediately.

Police also remind the residents in the vicinity to stay tuned to the latest situation, stay indoors and keep their windows shut, if necessary.
