The Government announced today (March 25) that Mrs Alice Cheung Chiu Hoi-yue, Deputy Secretary for Transport and Housing (Housing)/Deputy Director of Housing (Strategy), will take up the post of Director of Home Affairs on April 6, 2022.

She has served in various policy bureaux and departments, including the former Civil Service Branch, the former Trade and Industry Branch, the Home Affairs Department, the former Trade Department, the Civil Service Bureau, the Chief Secretary for Administration's Office, the Home Affairs Bureau and the Education Bureau. She was Deputy Secretary for Commerce and Economic Development (Commerce and Industry) from December 2010 to June 2016, Deputy Director of Environmental Protection from July 2016 to April 2019 and has been serving as Deputy Secretary for Transport and Housing (Housing)/Deputy Director of Housing (Strategy) since April 2019.
