Special traffic and transport arrangements for football match at Kai Tak Sports Park on June 10 and enhanced taxi pick-up/drop-off during dispersal

The Transport Department (TD) today (June 8) said that, to facilitate the holding of a football match at the Kai Tak Sports Park (KTSP) on the evening of June 10, special traffic and transport arrangements will be implemented to provide convenience for spectators to travel to and from the KTSP. As the traffic in the vicinity of the KTSP is expected to be heavy, spectators should opt for public transport and avoid driving.

The TD has co-ordinated with public transport operators to strengthen their services during the dispersal period. The MTR will enhance the interval between trains of the Tuen Ma Line. Franchised bus companies will provide a total of 10 special bus routes at the Sung Wong Toi Road Pick-up/Drop-off Area (PUDOA) to major districts across the territory.

In addition, relevant Government bureaux/departments and the KTSP Limited have reviewed the public transport arrangement of Sung Wong Toi Road PUDOA, and will open the Kai Tak Stadium Taxi PUDOA (G/F outside Gate H). For Sung Wong Toi Road PUDOA, it will remain open for taxi drop-off during admission period, and will be suspended for taxi pick-up/drop-off during the dispersal period. The taxi pick-up/drop-off arrangements in the vicinity of the KTSP during the event are set out below:

Sung Wong Toi Road PUDOA	Taxi drop-off only (from 4pm to 8pm)	No taxi pick-up/drop- off, for special bus routes only
Kai Tak Arena Taxi Drop-off Area	Taxi drop-off only (from 4pm to 8pm)	No taxi pick-up/drop- off

Relevant bureaux/departments and the KTSP Limited have arranged site visit and meeting with and issued letters to the taxi trade to facilitate its familiarisation of the new arrangements and routes concerned. Additional signage will also be put up on site for identification. During dispersal, the

expected waiting time will be longer amid an outflux of spectators and passengers' patience is appreciated.

Spectators are advised to take heed of the real-time information via the on-site broadcast and the "Easy Leave" platform (easyleave.police.gov.hk) as well as the latest traffic news through the TD's website (www.td.gov.hk), the "HKeMobility" mobile application and radio and television broadcasts.
