

Form: Permanent grassland assessment form: Countryside Stewardship

For farmers and land managers to assess if land is eligible for permanent grassland options GS2, GS5, GS6 or OT2.

Form: Capital grant application form: Countryside Stewardship

Applicants should use the capital grant form and relevant annex to apply for a grant for capital items for hedgerows and boundaries, or woodland support schemes.

Form: Shared grazing and common land: Environmental Stewardship

Tell the Rural Payments Agency if your Environmental Stewardship agreement includes shared grazing or common land (form es22 (CLA4)).

Form: Common land and shared grazing form: Countryside Stewardship

Use this form for Countryside Stewardship applications which include common land and shared grazing.

Form: HS6 and HS7 structural maintenance plan and record forms: Countryside Stewardship

Use these forms to inspect water bodies or water meadows and record any work undertaken as part of a Countryside Stewardship agreement.
