<u>Guidance: Importing animals and animal</u> <u>products if there's no Brexit deal</u>

If the UK leaves the EU in March 2019 without a deal, find out how this would affect anyone who imports animals, animal products and high-risk animal food and feed into the UK. This currently includes 'products of animal origin (POAO)' and 'specified food not of animal origin (FNAO)'. Changes are likely to affect both so-called 'transit consignments' and consignments originating within EU countries.

Guidance: Taking your pet abroad if there's no Brexit deal

If the UK leaves the EU in March 2019 without a deal, find out how this would affect pet owners who want to take their pets to the EU, and their vets (Official Veterinarians).

<u>Guidance: Accessing animal medicine IT</u> <u>systems if there's no Brexit deal</u>

If the UK leaves the EU in March 2019 without a deal, find out how this would affect IT systems relating to veterinary medicines, including systems used to submit data and reports.

If the UK leaves the EU in March 2019 without a deal, find out how this would affect the regulation of veterinary medicines.

<u>Guidance: Protecting geographical food</u> <u>and drink names if there's no Brexit</u> <u>deal</u>

If the UK leaves the EU in March 2019 without a deal, find out how this would affect producers of food products with GI protections. The UK currently has 86 products which have EU GI protection including foods, wines and spirits.
