



The resilience shown in this massive ancient oak is humbling. Rooted deep and standing tall for longer than anyone can remember at #whithaughtower.



Standing at the Anglo-Scottish border, the Bloody Bush stone pillar tells a centuries-old story of conflict and trade. Its ominous name dates back to the Border Reivers era (13th-17th centuries), when a brutal skirmish allegedly occurred here between English raiders and a Scottish warband in the 'Debatable Lands.'



Today's monument was erected in 1828 as a Toll Stone and border marker, a testament to the region's complex history.

A constant reminder that an "ending" is merely a transition, fueling the next wave of life.






Emerging out of the trees, the creature hunts for food. Have you seen one in the forest near you?






While we know that these creatures live in peace, it doesn't mean that they will not fight to protect their families and their way of life.
